Supplies needed for GATE...

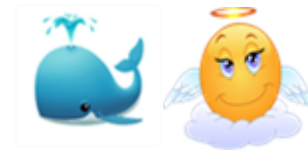
All GATE students are asked to bring in a composition notebook for GATE use only. Thank you to our GATE students/parents who have submitted composition notebooks.
